Trees Atlanta helps citizens protect and care for trees, shaping the course of development and replanting new trees for the future. Trees Atlanta also educates young people and adults about the diversity and value of our urban forest. In the 2010/2011 planting season, Trees Atlanta planted and cared for 2,171 shade trees in Atlanta with our volunteers and contractors. "NeighborWoods" program volunteers planted trees in public right-of-way areas and helped home and business owners plant shade trees on private land. During FY11, Trees Atlanta volunteers planted 1,535 NeighborWoods trees and Trees Atlanta also planted and distributed 6,305 seedlings. Trees Atlanta's Urban Tree program planted 636 fifteen foot tall trees in metro-Atlanta sidewalks, public spaces and on private commercial
